Presentation Information

There will be four formats for presentations at MIDTESOL 2017. The formats are concurrent session presentations, poster session presentations, Ed Tech Bazaar presentations, and Ed Tech Bazaar demonstrations.

Concurrent session presentations will be 45 minutes in length. These sessions could include such things as presenting research, leading a discussion, presenting as a panel, presenting practical applications and teaching ideas that work in the classroom, or presenting administrative practices.

Poster sessions will be held for 45 minutes at specified times during the conference. Specific guidelines for poster session presentations will be provided at the time of acceptance.

The Ed Tech Bazaar serves as a showcase area for practical applications of existing and emerging technology in the practice of TESOL. Proposals can be submitted for two formats in the Ed Tech Bazaar: presentations or demonstrations.

Ed Tech Bazaar Presentations are related to the practical application of existing or emerging technology. Presenters will clearly demonstrate how technology emerges or integrates with pedagogy within the context of the presentation. Specific examples of how the presenter has used the technology in his/her own classroom teaching context are recommended. These presentations are 45 minutes in length.

Ed Tech Bazaar demonstrations are 20 minutes in length and are given to small groups of people gathered around the presenter's table and repeated once for a total of 40 minutes. Presenters will introduce the functionality and purpose of an existing or emerging technology tool while demonstrating practical applications for use. For those doing an Ed Tech Demonstration, you will need to bring your own computer.

Crossroads for Colleague Connections (CCC): MIDTESOL has set aside rooms for "unconference" sessions. Topic discussion sessions will be 45 minutes in length. If you submit a topic by 5:00 pm on Friday, July 28, the topic and time will be printed in the program book.
